Chardonnay

DESCRIPTION

When Chardonnay was re-introduced to South Africa more than a decade ago, Nederburg was one of the first producers to plant this variety and it also undertook leading research on clonal selection at its Ernita vine nursery.

The 2002 Nederburg Chardonnay is a full-bodied white wine in which the wine character is not dominated by its wood components. The combination of subtle citrus and apricot notes together with the creamy and toasty flavours derived from partial barrel fermentation ensures a pleasant palate and a lingering aftertaste. It is an easy drinking wine, which should mature well over the next three to four years, provided it is correctly stored.

Perfect companion for creamy fish or chicken dishes, seafoods, veal or any generous white dishes.
